**Local Artists:** The trail features work by many local artists including this piece by Chris Bilton.

**Work by Children:** Gallery Town features work by local schoolchildren including this piece from Brinsworth Academy. Work included in the 2014 exhibition is a snapshot of some of the wonderful work created for the 'Picture This Exhibition' at the Rotherham Children's Festival. They were inspired by work by famous works but also by the work of local artists.

**Commissions:** This work by artist Chris Slater, was commissioned by Gallery Town.

**National Treasures:** Gallery Town works with the National Gallery, Sheffield Museums and Yorkshire Sculpture Park to select great works of art for display.

**Projects:** Each year we create new artworks with local children, residents and artists for events in the Town Centre including the 2012 Urban Pianos project (3 of the 9 pianos remain in the town centre for the public to play), the 2013 'Ferretstival' and in 2014 the 'Popped Art' Project will create permanent and temporary artworks for a summer event.
